

**POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP:
CALL FOR APPLICATIONS**
Montreal History Group – Groupe d’histoire de Montréal
2024-2025

The members of the Montreal History Group – Groupe d’histoire de Montréal welcome applications for a 9-month postdoctoral fellowship to be taken up during the academic year 2024-2025 (ideally from 1 September 2024 – 31 May 2025).

This postdoctoral fellowship of \$40,000 will be awarded to a researcher holding a doctorate¹ in history or a related field and whose project speaks to the current research themes and axes of the MHG-GHM (<https://ghm.uqam.ca/en/research/>). The successful applicant will work under the supervision of a member of the MHG-GHM attached to a Quebec university.

Candidates should submit their application (a 2-page letter detailing their doctoral research and the research that they intend to carry out while holding the postdoctoral fellowship, along with a CV) and arrange to have a reference letter sent separately to ghm.mhg@uqam.ca by **15 April 2024 at 17h**.

The successful recipient will be expected to participate actively in the events organized by the MHG-GHM (conferences, workshops, seminars, speaker series). Our discussions and activities take place in both English and French: passive bilingualism will be considered an asset.

The recipient of this postdoctoral fellowship should be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada. Applications from international candidates are welcome, but the successful applicant will need to obtain a work permit. Postdoctoral fellowships are generally considered by universities to be salaries: federal and provincial taxes, benefits, and union dues will thus be deducted from the award.

¹ University rules require that the doctorate have been obtained within the past 5 years.
